

**Criteria for acceptance into the National Honor Society
Giles High School**

Students with a minimum 3.45 GPA must fill out an Activity Information Form to be considered for membership. Students must demonstrate outstanding character, leadership, scholarship and service. Students will be chosen for membership based on the following criteria.

Character (25 points possible)

- No poor ratings by teachers (all excellent, good, or fair ratings) 25 points
- 1-2 poor ratings by teachers 20 points
- 3-4 poor ratings by teachers 15 points
- More than 5 teachers have issue 0 points
- Any disciplinary action regarding poor character 0 points

Leadership (25 points possible)

- Three or more leadership positions held 25 points
- Two leadership positions held 20 points
- One leadership position held 10 points
- No leadership positions held 0 points

Scholarship (25 points possible)

- A 3.45 GPA or higher 25 points
- Below 3.45 GPA 0 points

Service (25 points possible)**

- 6 non-school activities, work experience, school activities, service projects 25 points
- 4-5 non-school activities, work experience, school activities, service projects 20 points
- 3 non-school activities, work experience, school activities, service projects 10 points
- Less than 3 non-school activities, work experience school activities, service projects 0 points

**In addition, if a student works 20 or more hours a week, they will receive credit for 4 activities

Students must score **an 80 or higher** to be considered for acceptance into the National Honor Society at Giles High School. Other circumstances, as they arise, may influence the decision making process. Scoring an 80 or higher does not guarantee selection by the Faculty Committee.

Teacher and sponsor recommendations will also be a factor in the faculty committee's selection process.
